AVSI Lebanon Emergency Response

The conflict in Lebanon consistently escalated in the last months of 2024 with airstrikes impacting the South, the Bekaa Valley, and Beirut. Over 1.2 million people have been displaced, including members of AVSI staff. Since the end of September 2024, AVSI has been responding to this emergency providing essential support to thousands of displaced individuals, with a special focus on children.

BASIC ASSISTANCE



- 2507 blankets and 950 mattresses
- 1199 clothing pieces distributed
- 8 gas tanks distributed
- 200 households receiving multi-purpose cash
- 727 households receiving medicine and fuel vouchers

PROTECTION



- 1153 individuals supported through hotline services and referrals
- 3945 dignity kits distributed
- 222 caregivers receiving PSS
- 1469 children involved in PSS, PFA, and Art therapy activities

WATER, SANITATION and HYGIENE



- 2855 hygiene kits distributed
- 552 newborn kits distributed
- 4163 m³ of water delivered through water trucking
- 106 temporary showers and 14 toilets installed

FOOD SECURITY



- 1054 food kits distributed
- 2780 ready-to-eat meals and 100 hot meals provided

EDUCATION



- 157 CWD and PWD identified through specialized assessments
- 2111 children receiving individual student kits and/or learning materials

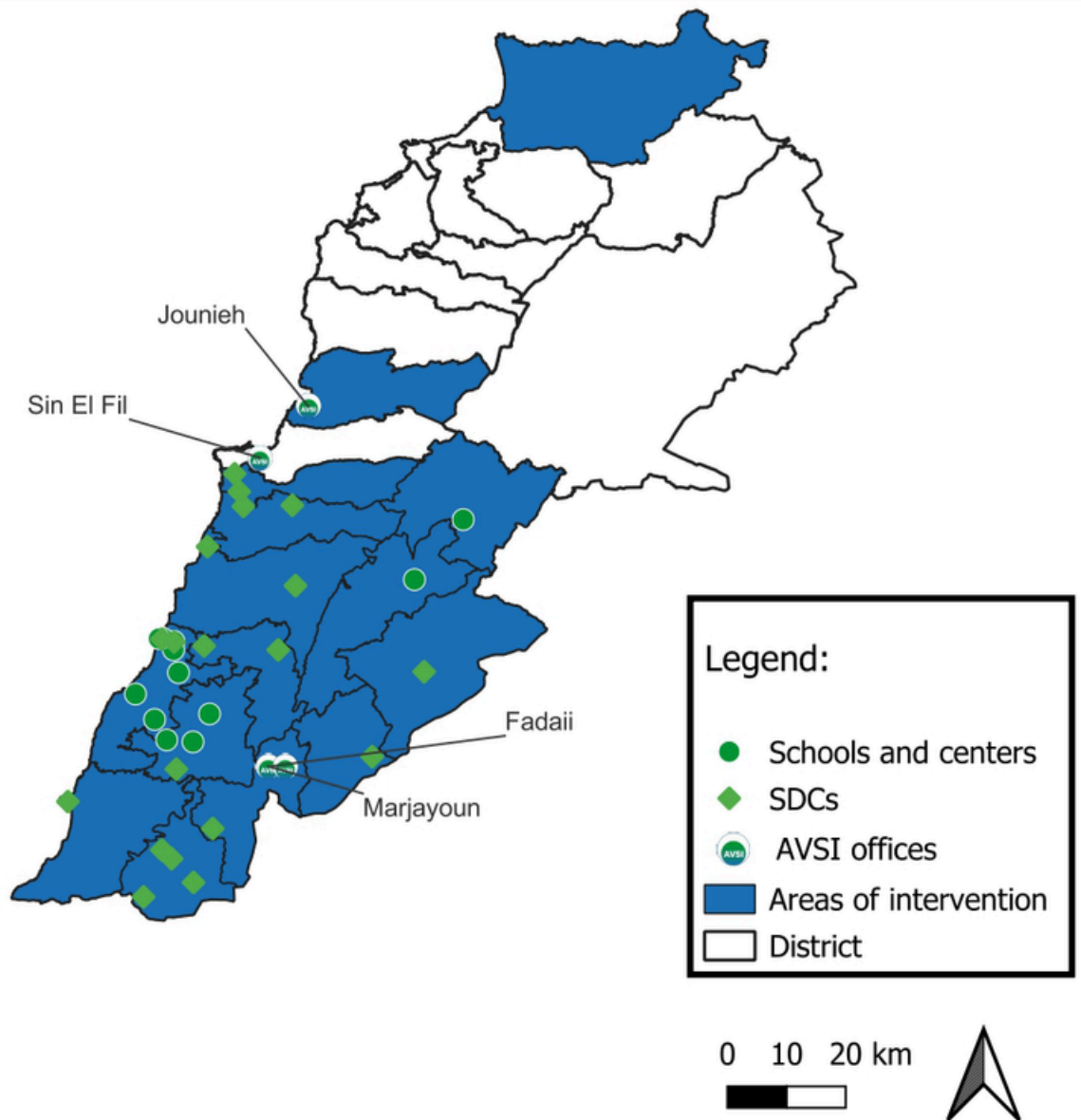
