














BACK TO THE FUTURE IV

Protective environment and educational opportunities for vulnerable boys and girls in Lebanon.

The "Back to the Future" project aims to ensure that vulnerable girls and boys in marginalized communities in Lebanon have access to inclusive quality education. The project ensures the provision of non-formal education programs targeting out-of-school refugee children at risk of dropping-out from formal education. Moreover, the project provides a protective environment and supports the wellbeing of children and their families to support their engagement in educational activities.

The phase four (IV) of the project was implemented by AVSI and Terre des Hommes Italy in Lebanon, funded by the European Union Humanitarian Aid.


Phase IV July 2022 – October 2023

The project focused on the preparation, completion, and referral of children for the scholastic years 2023-2024.


A robust teachers' professional development approach was implemented to promote academic preparedness for children and transition to formal education.

Caregivers, teachers and communities were engaged to establish a protective environment for children and support their educational success.

Through an integrated approach, all learners were provided with targeted psychosocial support activities and access to case management, inclusion, and protection services.
